Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."

Novice Class - shall be for dogs six months of age and over, which have not, prior to the date of closing of entries, won three first prizes in the Novice Class, a first prize in Amateur-Owner- Handler, Bred-by-Exhibitor, American-bred, or Open Classes, nor one or more points toward their championships.

Amateur-Owner-Handler - For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler.

Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered in this competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

The Club offers an Award of Merit to deserving Labrador Retrievers for recognition of their quality. It is entirely at the judges' discretion to award up to six (6) superior quality Labrador Retrievers in the Best of Breed intersex competition (to include Veteran and Hunting Retriever class winners and Winners Dog and Winners Bitch); the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex winners are not eligible to receive an Award of Merit.

BEST PUPPY AND BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR

Best Puppy competition will be for winners of the regular puppy dog and puppy bitch classes only, including 6-9, 9-12 months. Dogs over 12 months of age are not considered puppies. Best Bred-By Exhibitor competition will be for the winners of the Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy & Adult classes only. Only dogs/bitches not defeated are eligible for Best Puppy and Best Bred- by Exhibitor Competition.

OFFERED ALL SHOWS

BEST PUPPY, BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR, BEST VETERAN

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (Monday Only)

Stud Dog. For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. Get must be entered in a Regular class, Best of Breed or some other Non-Regular class. The Stud Dog may be entered in Stud Dog class competition only at the regular entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or be excused under the Stud Dog rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed.

Brood Bitch. Same class as Stud Dog Class, but substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace - Two dogs of the same breed, intact and having at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Dogs need not be entered in one of the Regular Classes, Non-Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class".

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

-- FOREIGN REGISTRATION --

For exhibitors entering dog(s) with foreign registration, please be aware ...

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. An unregistered dog with an acceptable foreign registration that is individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration may, without special AKC approval, be exhibited in licensed or member dog shows that are held not later than 30 days after the date of the first licensed or member dog show in which the dog was exhibited, but only provided that the individual foreign registration and name of the country of birth, are shown on the entry form; and provided further that the same name (which in the case of a foreign-registered dog must be the name on the foreign registrations) is used for the dog each time.

Foreign dogs not individually registered with The American Kennel Club when first exhibited in a licensed or member dog show shall not be eligible to be exhibited in any licensed or member dog show that is held more than 30 days after the date of the first licensed or member dog show in which it was exhibited, unless the dog's individual AKC registration number is shown on the entry form, or unless the owner has received from The American Kennel Club an extension notice in writing authorizing further entries of the dog for a specified time with its individual foreign registration number. No such extension will be granted unless the owner can clearly demonstrate, in a letter addressed to the Show Records Department of The American Kennel Club requesting such extension, that the delay in registration is due to circumstances for which he is not responsible. Such extension notice will be void upon registration of the dog or upon expiration of the period for which the extension has been granted if that occurs earlier, but upon application further extensions may be granted. Additionally, any unregistered dog with an acceptable foreign registration must be eligible for the individual class in which it is entered as outlined in Chapter 3 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (Tuesday Only)

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler and Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC (919) 233-9767, juniors@akc.org. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Eligibility: This Sweepstakes is open to purebred Labrador Retrievers, who, on the day of the show, will be at least six months and under eighteen months of age. Champions of record and Professional Handlers are eligible to compete. Classes to be divided by sex and age. Sweepstake Classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. **Dogs shown in Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes.** Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

Eligibility: This Veteran Sweepstakes is open to any dog, Champion, or non-champion, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 yrs of age. Neutered males and spayed bitches are eligible for Veteran Sweepstakes. Judging will be held prior to regular classes. A dog **DOES NOT** have to be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Indicate "Sweepstake and Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**



Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

JOIN US FOR PEE WEE EVENT – TUESDAY ONLY

Come out and cheer on our pee wee handlers, Saturday during lunch break. For more information Show Chair: Julie Jussaume, juljuss@yahoo.com (Geared for children ages 5-9)

The Judge (Cheryl Curtis) will mentor the participants. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, their responsible adult, and the dog. This is not a competitive class, but rather a FUN learning experience for the child and the adult.

- ✓ Entry Fee has been waived by the club. There is NO COST for this event. Entries will be accepted on the day of the event.
- ✓ A dog must be at least 4 months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- ✓ All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- ✓ A responsible adult must be present.
- ✓ Dogs that are allowed: Labrador Retriever only.
- ✓ A release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Pee Wee Release of Liability will be available at the show.
- ✓ The safety of the dog and child inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both the child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience – the Pee Wee will not be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for showing in AKC Junior Showmanship in the future. Each child will receive a participation rosette, and a gift, to commemorate the experience.

THERE IS NO PRE-ENTRY, but it is helpful for planning to know the number of Pee Wee Participants to expect. 1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, DogZibit, P. O. Box 2044, Woodinville, WA 98072-2044 by the closing date and time specified in the Premium List. After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapt 11, Sect 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX, email, phone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with this agreement. Rule books may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for incorrect or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent which includes entering a dog in a class which the dog is not eligible to compete. **Responsibility for completeness of entry rests solely with entrant. Note: When you enter online, you agree to the same terms found on the official AKC Entry form found in the Premium.**
3. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted and required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS \$30.00 NSF fee. 10. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging.
